

Privacy Policy

At Tecom Group, Inc. we treat your concerns about privacy and personal data protection with the highest importance. This Privacy Policy applies entirely to information collected through our websites and applications.

In this Privacy Policy we provide a clear and transparent notice regarding the collection, use and protection of your personal data. We also describe how you can reach us to update and correct, export or delete your information. Please read this Privacy Policy carefully and make sure you understand it clearly. Consent

By accessing and using our websites and applications, you indicate your consent to the collection, use, disclosure and protection of your personal data in accordance with the following Privacy Policy. Please be aware that your information may be processed by Tecom Group, Inc. in the United States and other countries where our services reside. Collection and Usage of Personal Data

Interacting with us may require processing certain types of information about you including, but not limited to the following:

- Contact information you provide when you create an account or sign in (such as your name, username, password, e-mail, telephone number, company name, address, etc.);
- Payment information you provide when you purchase our software (such as your bank account information, debit or credit card number, CVV code, expiration date, payment history etc.);
- Usage information (such as Internet Protocol ("IP") addresses, log files, unique device identifiers, pages viewed, computer and browser types, screen resolution, operating system version and other usage information collected from cookies and other tracking technologies to measure usage of our site; this does not include any personally identifiable information).

We reasonably use your personal data to identify you and to contact you. We may communicate with you via e-mail, telephone, social media or via our websites and applications.

We also collect, use and store information about you for some other purposes:

- We may retain any contact data you provide in order to send you information about our products and services that may be of interest to you. Still we provide you with the opportunity to opt-out of receiving such promotional communications. In particular, you can opt-out of receiving marketing-related emails by following the unsubscribe instructions provided in each email.
- We have the right to notify you of changes to our websites, products or services that could affect our service to you.
- From time to time we may ask you to take part in our surveys, to complete questionnaires or provide feedback.
- We may collect certain types of usage information to gather statistical information about our websites usage in order to continually improve its design and functionality, understand how individuals use it, and to assist us with resolving questions regarding it. Some technologies are used to track the actions of website users and compile statistics about website usage.
- We do not reveal identifiable information about you to our advertisers, though we may at times share statistical information with them.

Use of Cookies

Cookies are small files that a website or its service provider transfers to your computer's hard drive through your web browser (if you allow) that enables the website's or service provider's systems to recognize your browser and capture and remember certain information.

We use cookies in our websites and applications to help us understand your preferences based on previous or current activity, which enables us to provide you with improved services. We also use cookies to understand and save your preferences for future visits and compile aggregate data about website traffic and website interaction so we can offer better website experiences and tools in the future.

If you prefer, you can choose to have your computer warn you each time a cookie is being sent, or you can choose to turn off all cookies via your browser settings. If you set your browser to decline cookies, some of our services may not function properly.

Protection and Storage of Information

We use professional software and secured networks to ensure the privacy of transmitted data.

Your personal data is only accessible by a limited number of persons who have special access rights and are required to keep the information confidential.

We use strong SSL encryption to protect your sensitive information in transit. All transactions are processed through a gateway provider and are not stored or processed on our servers.

We always do our best to protect your information. However there is always a slight risk of external attacks, so we cannot guarantee complete safety of your data. But we assume our responsibility in notifying you of data breaches which may put you at risk as soon as possible so that you can take appropriate measures.

Information Sharing

We may disclose your personal data to:

- our third party service providers (websites and applications hosting, debit or credit card processing, e-mail marketing and auditing operations) in order to enable them to provide services;
- a third party in the event of any reorganization, merger, sale, joint venture, assignment, transfer, or other disposition of all or any portion of our business, assets, or stock (including in connection with any bankruptcy or similar proceedings);

- response to requests from public and government authorities and comply with any legal process;
- any third party when we have your consent.

Third Party Sites and Services
