Discussion Questions for Junior High and High School Students

Write down, or discuss as a family, your answers to the following questions:

1. Where else in Scripture is Jesus shown to be King other than Matthew 21:1-11? Try to find at least three more places.
2. Now that you've established Jesus's *position* as King, what are a few Scriptures that reveal His *disposition* (character/nature) as King?
3. How does Jesus' Kingly character differ from King Saul and King Nebuchadnezzar? Which type of king would you want to be a subject of and why?
4. In the lesson, we asked three questions, what were they? (After writing them down, continue to the next page)

5. Spend 10-15 minutes in Worship Response alone with the Holy Spirit. Start by turning Psalm 139:23-24 into a prayer to Him and then ask Him to help you answer those three questions about your own heart toward Jesus as King. Bonus Challenge: Every day this week, spend time searching the Scriptures about what God says about Himself and start making a list. In the days to come, when our circumstances tempt us toward incorrect thoughts about Who our King is, go back to this list and let the Scriptures remind you about Who the Father, Son, and Spirit truly are.
