

God Statement: Jesus is Life

Read in your Bible: John 11

Question #1:

Why did Jesus bring Lazarus back to life? (Read John 11:4, 41-42)

Question #2:

How would you have responded if you had seen Lazarus raised from the dead? (John 11:43-45)

Question #3:

Do you think witnessing this miracle would have changed your life? Why or Why not?

Question #4:

Due to Christ's finished work on the cross, how does Jesus' authority over death affect our lives today?

Question #5:

How does this miracle influence the way you see Jesus?

Worship Response:

Often times we look at the person of Jesus and see Him as a good teacher, friend or leader. But rarely do we take the time to see Jesus as our Life. The only way we can have restored and renewed relationship with the God of the universe is through the person and work of Jesus Christ. Take some this week and focus on the truth that Jesus is your life. The one who makes your faith possible and puts breath in your lungs. Identify and write down the areas in which you feel discouraged or hopeless and trust Jesus to bring life to those places.

Further Reading (Optional)

Take a few days and slowly read through 2 Corinthians 5:11-21. The Apostle Paul is talking about the ministry of reconciliation. This work allows those who put their faith in Christ to be a "New Creation" in Christ. Take time and memorize verse 17. This is a great reminder to the people of God that Jesus is Life.
