The Big God Story Genesis - Revelation

Discover

- In John 1:1 we get a glimpse of the time before the creation of the world. “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.”
- Creation springs into existence. The beautiful story holds such promise. Creation is a paradise. Then, as with any story, we come to a crisis. People want to rule themselves, and they turn their backs on their Creator.
- When all appears lost, God comes to the rescue. Through the death of an innocent, one day God will cover us and will rescue us from our impossible predicament.
- The rest of the story displays mankind’s unending weakness and God’s unending grace. God does send that innocent One to His death, takes away our sins, and invites us into that story.

Experience

This week, plan a special time to celebrate The Big God Story with your children. You can go all out with balloons and decorations, or just keep it simple and provide a special treat to share together. Invite your children to share their favorite parts of The Big God Story. Then give them an opportunity to act out those parts, using props and costumes if available. End your time together by praising God for all He’s done throughout The Big God Story and by thanking Him for including us in His big story.

Follow

While celebrating The Big God Story, discuss these questions together:

- What amazes you most about The Big God Story?
- What have you learned about God throughout The Big God Story?
- How does it make you feel to know you’re a part of God’s big story?


These questions can easily extend into the rest of the week. Look for opportunities to have conversations about how you are in God’s big story throughout your everyday life.




