Please review the following discussion questions in order.

God Statement: God is the One True God

Family Memory Verse: 'Do you not know? Have you not heard? The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He will not grow tired or weary, and his understanding no one can fathom. ' Isaiah 40:28

Bible Lesson: Exodus 5–11, The Ten Plagues

Discussion Questions: Allow **all** the children to answer the questions.

1. What did God say His name is? Exodus 6:1-8 (Yahweh)
2. Why is His name important? Exodus 3:14 (it's the name God called himself used when He spoke to Abraham)
3. Why did God want His people to leave Egypt? Exodus 5:1; 6:6-7 (so God's people could hold a festival and worship Him freely and for the world to know that they are God's people)
4. What did God tell Moses to say to Pharaoh? 5:1 (To let His people go)
5. Why did God send the plagues? Exodus 9:16 (To show His Power)
6. How do you know God was fighting for the Israelites?
7. How does God show us He is the Lord?
8. How do know God fights for His people?
9. How do you know God loves you and hears your cries?

Prayer Time:

- Ask every student to give a prayer request.
- Write each prayer down on the back of this paper.
- Take time to pray for every prayer request; please have students pray for each other in the group setting.

- What's your favorite song?
- What's your favorite food?
