

Remember and Celebrate Family Worship Response Elementary

Purpose: So this is something that comes directly from Scripture that we can pass on to children and their families. A thing that we can do that actually changes culture, it changes our attitude, it changes our heart posture. When we look at Scripture we see that God was very intentional about his people remembering. In fact, he established 7 annual feasts, festivals that the people of Israel were supposed to celebrate regularly. During these times they were specifically instructed to remember different things about their heritage or how God had provided for them or His goodness to them.

Supplies for Activity:

- Bible
- Paper
- Pen
- Music

Activity: Remembering God's Goodness

- Play music
- Ask your family what are something God has done for them in the past.
- Give them 5 minutes to write them down
- If they cant think of anything, have them pray that the Holy Spirit would remind them
- After everyone has written the things Down that god has done for them/and you family. Go around sharing your stories.
- Take time after everyone's has shared to pray to and worship God, thanking God for what He has done!

Remember and Celebrate: ZONK! Bible Trivia

Verse: Deuteronomy 7:9 Know therefore that the LORD your God is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, to a thousand generations,

Purpose: When we look at Scripture, we see that God was very intentional about his people remembering. This is a fun game to help your child remember some of the things they learned about God in the past lessons.

Supplies Needed:

- Something you child could ring or grab (water bottle, toy, or bell)
- Question and answer sheet (provided below)

Instructions:

- Split your family up into two even teams
- Have one member from each team stand with the bell or object in between them
- One person will read the question
- The first person to ring the bell or grab the object first gets to answer the question.
- If they get it right their team gets a point
- If they get it wrong their opponent gets a chance to answer the question
- If they get it right their team gets the point
- If both players get it wrong, they have to place the bell/object back and go to their teams for help
- The player who rings/grabs the object get to answer if they are right their team gets a point
- The team with the most points at the end of the game wins!

Questions and Answers

1. True or False: God allowed the first people to stay in the perfect garden with Him after they had sinned.

ANSWER: False. Because of their sin, the first people were separated from God.

2. Whom did God plan to send after the first people sinned?
 - a. A stork
 - b. A dinosaur
 - c. A Redeemer
 - d. A grandma

ANSWER: C. God promised to send a Redeemer—Jesus Christ—to heal the broken relationship between God and people.

3. What did God do to the people building a tall tower to make themselves famous?
 - a. He took away their allowance
 - b. He made them wash dishes
 - c. He confused their languages
 - d. He made them leave the garden

ANSWER: C. God confused their languages and scattered them all over the world.

4. Why did God call Abraham to leave his family and his homeland?
 - a. So Abraham could get out and try lots of new kinds of food
 - b. So God could start a new nation of people who would worship only Him
 - c. Because God likes the beach and wanted Abraham to see it
 - d. Because Abraham's dad had allergies

ANSWER: B

ANSWER: D

9. True or False: God sent the plagues to prove that He is the only real God.

ANSWER: True

- c. Cook with it
- d. Nothing

ANSWER: B. God told His people to put the blood of the lamb on their doorposts to save them from death.

11. BONUS QUESTION: Who is the true Passover Lamb?

ANSWER: Jesus. Just like God told His people to put the blood of the lamb over their doorposts to save them from death, God tells us that the blood of Jesus made the way for us to be saved from sin and death.
