Family Worship Response

Elementary

Purpose: Today we can hear God's voice just like Moses did. We might not hear God talking to us from a burning bush, but we can still hear Him and speak to Him. We can hear from God by reading His Word, praying to Him, feeling something while listening to a worship song, looking at a picture of His creation, and other ways. Sometimes we don't hear from Him at all, and that's okay, because we know He still hears us.
