Moses :: Plagues | Exodus 5-11

Repetition is an important part of your child's development and growth. Enjoy re-reading the story and declaring God is the One True God throughout the day. Use the extra activities to connect with God's Word this week.

PRAY

Moses was a sweet little baby boy, but a mean king wanted to get rid of all the baby boys.

Moses' mama was wise to trust God with her baby boy. She placed him in a basket in the water and God brought the mean king's daughter to rescue Moses.

God would later use Moses to rescue all of His people from this mean king and show that He is the One True God! To this day people still celebrate what God did through Moses during Passover. WOW!

- Ask God to show you ways He is the One True God.
- Thank God for His Word that reveals who He is.

EXPERIENCE




Some different plagues God sent were darkness, frogs, flies, locusts, turning the Nile to blood, and boils. God proved to Pharaoh, the Egyptians, and the Israelites that **He alone is the One True God!**

Discover

- The Israelites needed to learn more about their great God. They needed to trust Him and know that He is the One True God.
- God chose specific plagues that corresponded with the deities of the Egyptians.
- When God changed the water to blood, God judged the Nile River itself, which had been deified as a god.
- Through all of the plagues, God proved He alone had the right to His people. He alone is the One True God.

Experience

Each night this week, take your kids outdoors. **Read Exodus 5-11**, one chapter per night. Each night, after you've read, ask your kids how they might have reacted if they'd been there to witness GOD's power to control nature. Point out that God was proving that He alone is God.

Follow

After reading through **Exodus 5-11**, discuss these questions together:

- Why did God want His people to leave Egypt?
- Why did God send the plagues?
- How does God show His power today?

These questions can easily extend into the rest of the week. Look for opportunities to have conversations about how God is the One True God throughout your everyday life as a family.


