## **Family Worship Response**

### **Elementary**

**Purpose:** Today's part of The Big God Story shows us how God never fails His people, no matter how hard, scary, or impossible the circumstances seem. The Jordan River might have looked impossible to cross, but God told His people to cross it. God said He would be with them, and He was. God won't always take away the hard things in our lives, but He never leaves us alone. He always loves us. He always wants what's best for us and guides us toward the right path. And He's always faithful to give us peace and rest for our souls in all situations.

- Turn on music.
- Encourage kids to think of a time that God was faithful.
- On the rock, write the truth that the children remember.
- As a family, you can decide if you want to keep the rocks somewhere to remember OR place them outside.

- How is God faithful to us?
- When was a time God did not fail you?
